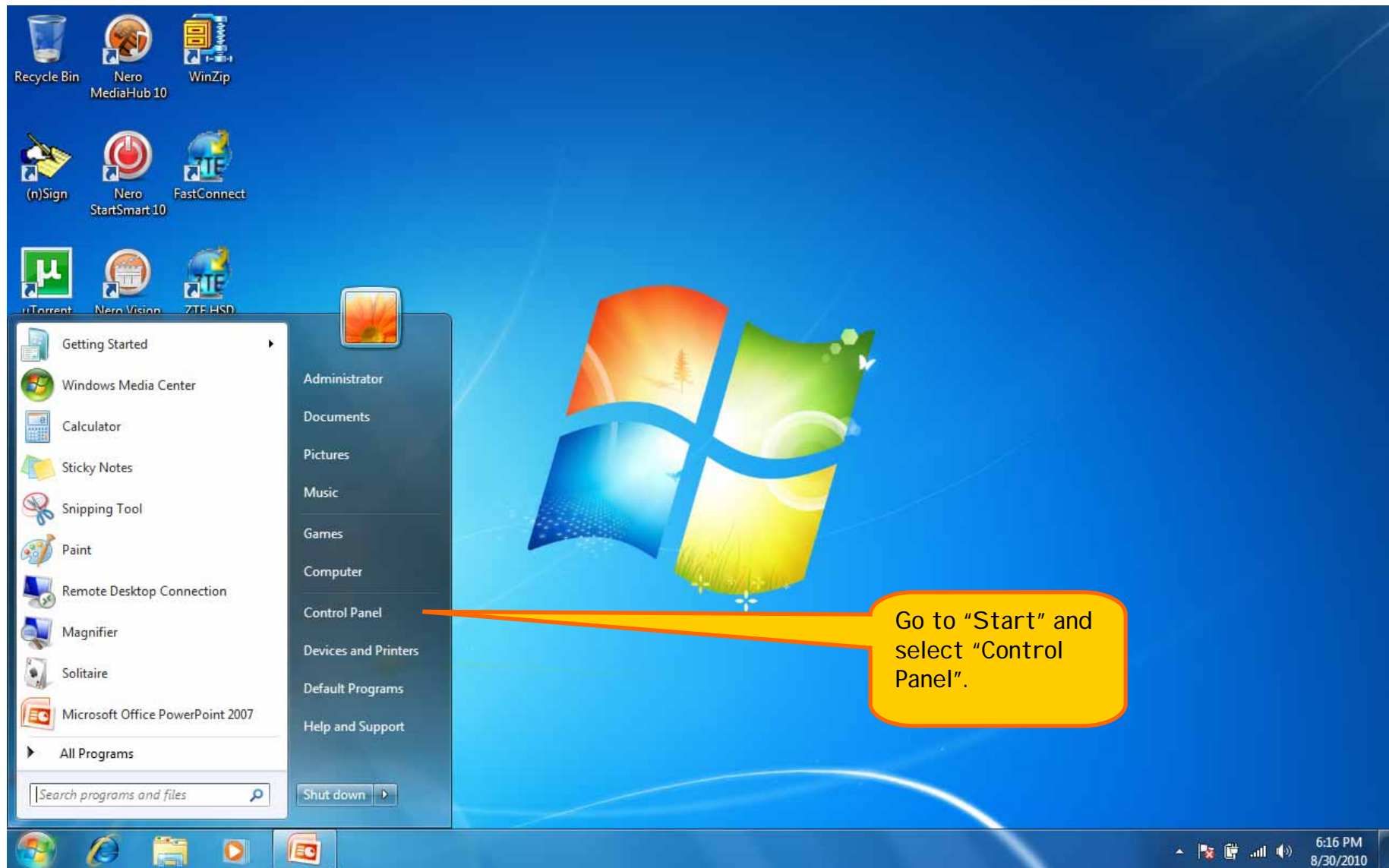

What are network locations?

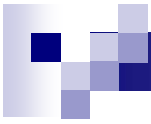
Home or work (private) networks	Connected
Networks at home or work where you know and trust the people and devices on the network	
Windows Firewall state:	On
Incoming connections:	Block all connections to programs that are not on the list of allowed programs
Active home or work (private) networks:	GNFC
Notification state:	Notify me when Windows Firewall blocks a new program
Public networks	Not Connected

### Customize settings for each type of network

You can modify the firewall settings for each type of network location that you use.

What are network locations?

#### Home or work (private) network location settings

- Turn on Windows Firewall
  - Block all incoming connections, including those in the list of allowed programs
  - Notify me when Windows Firewall blocks a new program
- Turn off Windows Firewall (not recommended)

#### Public network location settings

- Turn on Windows Firewall
  - Block all incoming connections, including those in the list of allowed programs
  - Notify me when Windows Firewall blocks a new program
- Turn off Windows Firewall (not recommended)

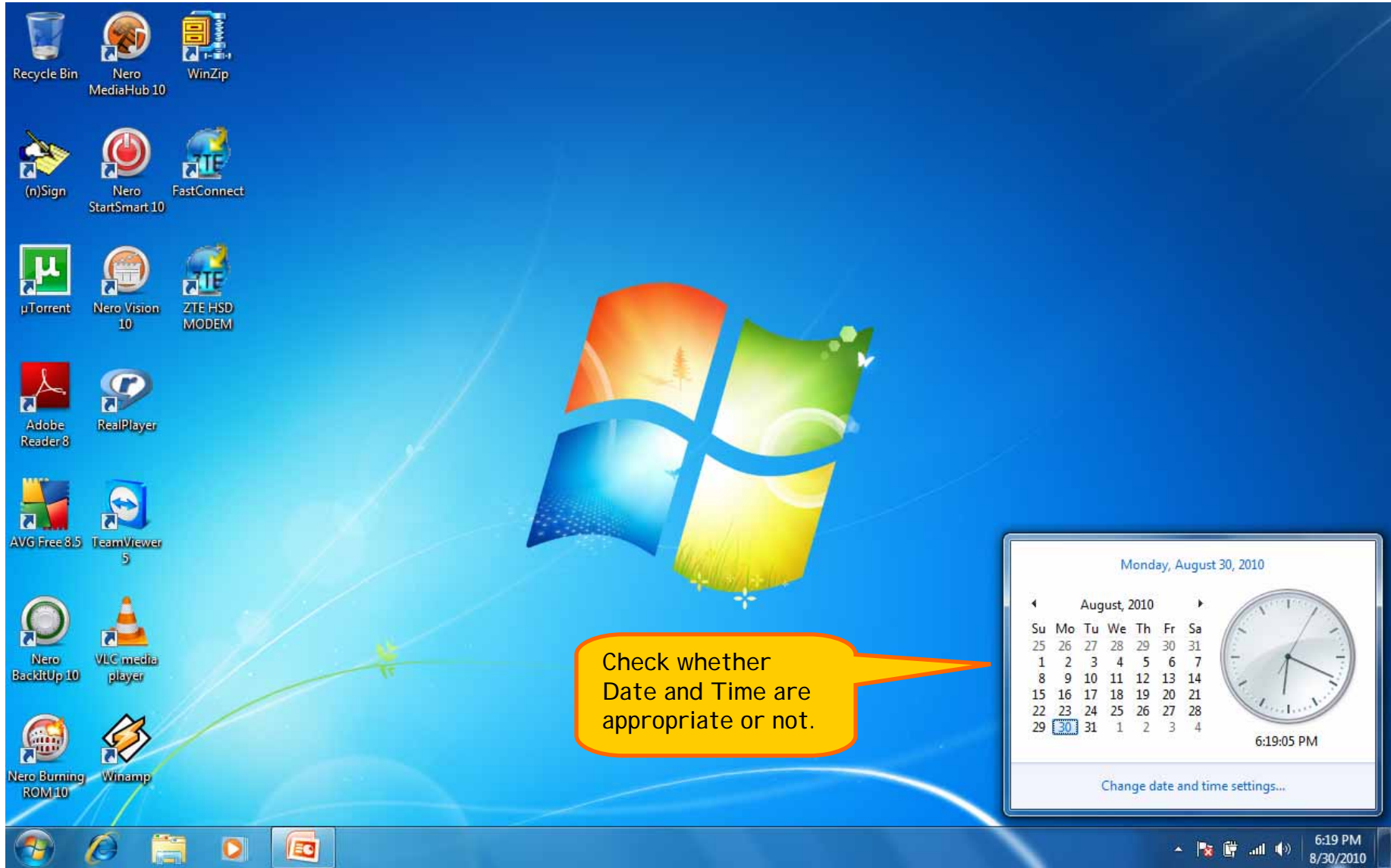
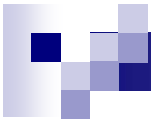

After Security setting, now click on "Privacy" and uncheck "Turn on Pop up Blocker" option. Now restart the "Internet Explorer" and start your work.
